Headquarters Dispatch - President General, Russell Page relates that "funds were received from the Robert Friend Trust as a result of the settlement of a law suit filed by his widow, Mrs Robert S Friend in 1997. That suit sought to change the terms of the Trust." --- "The change sought by Mrs Friend would have permitted her to remove the charities, including the National Society, as beneficiaries. In our opinion, National Society Officers had a fiduciary responsibility to defend the gift given to the Society by Compatriot Friend.---."

The National Society received \$1.4 million paid immediately as a result of an out-of-court settlement.

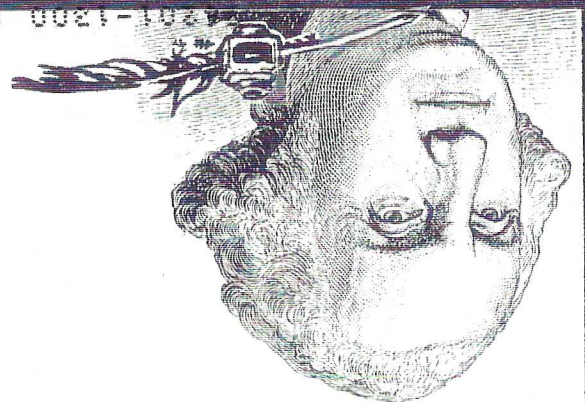
