- Program – "The Whiskey Rebellion" presented by Randall Bush. Randall was born just south of Pittsburgh Pennsylvania on May 16, 1956. He grew up in the small town of Canonsburg, which resides about 20 miles southwest of the city. This area is considered the center of the Whiskey Rebellion. He is a member of the Plano Chapter of the Texas SAR and serves as its Secretary. Randall is also a dual member with the Col. William Grayson Chapter of the Virginia SAR where his Patriot Ancestor, Lieut. William Reeve, was born and enlisted. By trade, Randall is an automotive restoration shop manager, technician, and historian.
